What is done during a health check-up for children?

At every appointment, the pediatrician checks on various things that are important for your child's growth.

For example, the doctor examines:

- ✓ How is your child's body doing, i. e.
 - their eyes,
 - their ears,
 - their lungs,
 - their heart,
 - their stomach,
 - their bones and,
 - their blood?
- √ How does your child move?
- √ How does your child speak?
- √ How does your child interact with people?
- ✓ Does your child need a vaccination or other treatments?

All examinations are paid for by the health insurance companies and are free of charge for you!
